1. All rabbits will be judged according to the latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
2. The latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association will govern.
3. Entry fee is \$0.50 for each rabbit – this should be mailed with your entry. Please make checks payable to **Wayne County Fair**.
4. Classes will be – Senior Buck, Senior Doe, Junior Buck, and Junior Doe.
5. All rabbits must have a permanent tattoo.
6. Exhibitors must have all entries listed for competition on the fairgrounds between **12 Noon to 9:00 PM, Thursday, August 4, 2016**. All entries shall remain on the premises until **10:00 PM, Saturday, August 13, 2016** unless released by the superintendent. Entries may be picked up on **Saturday, August 13, 2016, from 10:00 PM – 11:00 PM and Sunday, August 14, 2016, from 7:00 AM until 12 Noon**. Judging will be on **Saturday, August 6, 2016 starting at 8:00 AM**.
7. The management reserves the right to reduce the number of entries from one party if cooping facilities are exhausted. Entries will be received until such time as the cooping capacity is reached. Entry forms will be mailed to the last two years' exhibitors.
8. Rabbits will be fed, watered, and cared for by competent employees. Rabbits will only be handled by the judge or authorized fair officials.
