1. All animals must have an official ear tag or official legible breed registration tattoo.
2. No goats showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease, including footrot, sore mouth, caseous lymphadenitis, active ring worm, warts, lice and mange, will be admitted to any show. All goats will be checked as they are unloaded and before they are placed in their pens. An accredited veterinarian shall sign an official statement of health issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry and it must accompany all goats for show. The Superintendent of the goat section or an accredited veterinarian, at his discretion, can physically palpate or handle goats entered for competition for any of the aforementioned contagious or infectious diseases or ailments of goats.
3. Please check "Health Rules" section of this premium book for all health rules and regulations.
4. ****Be sure to use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat and dairy animals when fitting your animals for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat or milk. If you are not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat or dairy animals, DO NOT USE IT!! **Important** If upon slaughter, treatment with drugs, biologics, or any chemical from fitting products, is the cause of condemnation of a carcass, the loss of the carcass and any other damages will be borne by the exhibitor.****
5. All goats must be on the grounds between **3:00 PM and 7:00 PM on Thursday, August 1, 2024**. Goats will be released at **8:00 PM on Sunday, August 4, 2024**.
6. NOTICE: Breed and tag number must be on all entry forms.
7. Hay nets and bags are prohibited in goat pens.
8. All dairy goats must be dehorned

9. **Entry forms must be submitted by July 1, 2024 to Wayne County Fair Office- 270 Miller Drive, Honesdale PA 18431. There is an entry fee of \$1.00 per animal.**

20. Best Doe in Show – All Breeds **Rosette**

NOTE

1. Get of Sire – shall consist of three (3) does from a particular sire. Need not all be from one herd. **Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the sire.**
2. Produce of Dam – shall consist of two(2) does of different ages, the produce of dam need not be opened by one exhibitor. **Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the dam.**
3. Dam and Daughter – any age, need not be owned by the same exhibitor. **No animal may appear in more than one pair within this class.**

**SECTION 2
OPEN MEAT GOATS**

1. Classes will be determined by weight.
2. Minimum weight – 50 lbs. Maximum weight – 120 lbs.

**SECTION 3
OPEN GOATS – GOOD HOUSEKEEPING AWARDS**

1. Goat exhibitors maintaining the most attractive and sanitary exhibits will be eligible for special daily premiums.
2. All goat exhibitors will be scored on the following basis:

Cleanliness of animals	15 points
Cleanliness of bedding	15 points
Entry card & ribbon properly displayed	20 points
Keeping grain & hay feed presentable	10 points
Keeping all equipment sanitary & neat	10 points
Keeping aisles clean	15 points
Courtesy to people	<u>15 points</u>
TOTAL	100 points

3. Inspections will be made unannounced and prizes will be awarded on a daily basis. Exhibits will be judged on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
