- 1. Due to state regulations, 4-H & FFA Swine are prohibited from entering in the open classes.
- 2. Please check "Health Rules" section of this premium book for all health rules and regulations.
- 3. No swine species shall be exhibited in Pennsylvania unless each animal:
 - Is accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) issued within 14 days of the exhibition.
 - Is permanently identified by an official 840 series radio frequency identification (RFID) ear tag and the ear tag number is recorded on the CVI.
 - Has a visual number tag.
 - Has been visually inspected and found to be free of signs of contagious disease immediately prior to unloading at the exhibition by an accredited veterinarian or swine health monitor appointed by the fair board or livestock show committee.
- 4. **Be sure to use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat and dairy animals when fitting your animals for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat or milk. If you are not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat or dairy animals, DO NOT USE IT!! **Important** If upon slaughter, treatment with drugs, biologics, or any chemical from fitting products, is the cause of condemnation of a carcass, the loss of the carcass and any other damages will be borne by the exhibitor.**
- 4. Exhibitors must have all animals listed for competition on the grounds between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM, Thursday, August 3, 2023. Open swine animals are released between 6:00 AM & 8:00 AM on Sunday, August 6, 2023 NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. Entry forms must be submitted by July 1, 2023 to Wayne County Fair, 270 Miller Drive, Honesdale, PA 18431. There is an entry fee of \$1.00 per animal.
- 6. Minimum weight for swine **150lbs**.
